

ORDINANCE NO. 25-09

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS, ADOPTING AND ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR THE PROVISION OF UTILITY SERVICES; REPEALING OTHER SUCH FEE SCHEDULES HERETOFORE ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE, RESOLUTION OR MOTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Webster, Texas has determined that certain utility fees shall be established by ordinance;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEBSTER, TEXAS:**

SECTION 1: That all previous fees and charges heretofore approved, adopted, and levied by the City Council of the City of Webster, by ordinance, resolution or motion are hereby repealed to the extent they are in conflict with the charges approved in this ordinance and in all other respects this ordinance shall be cumulative of other ordinances regulating and governing the subject matter covered by this ordinance.

SECTION 2: That the City of Webster schedule of charges, setting forth the amount to be charged for the connection to or consumption of utility services furnished by the City of Webster, which schedule is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof for all purposes, is hereby approved, adopted and levied.

SECTION 3: If any provisions, section, exceptions, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances, shall for any reason be held unconstitutional, void or invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances and to this end all provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4: The fee and charges set forth in Exhibit "A" of this Ordinance shall become effective on the billing of the month following approval and adoption upon second and final reading.





**EXHIBIT "A"**

**Utility Rate Structure**

The following monthly rates shall hereafter be charged for potable water service furnished through or available from water meters.

**Minimum Bill Based on Meter Size (All Classes)**

<u>Size</u>	<u>Monthly Charge</u>
5/8 inch	\$12.00
3/4 inch	13.20
1 inch	16.80
1 1/2 inch	21.61
2 inch	34.81
3 inch	132.03
4 inch	168.04
6 inch	252.06
8 inch	300.07
10 inch	348.09

For the residential class, the minimum charge includes 0-2,000 gallons for essential domestic service.

**Domestic Service Volumetric Rate by Customer Class per Thousand Gallons**

Residential: \$4.85 per thousand gallons above 2,000 gallons.

Apartments: \$5.53 per thousand gallons.

Commercial: \$5.68 per thousand gallons.

These rates exclude irrigation only meters.

Exhibit "A" continued

**Irrigation Service Tiered Volumetric Rate per Thousand Gallons (All Classes)**

0-5,000 Gallons	\$5.00
5,001-20,000 Gallons	7.00
20,001-50,000 Gallons	10.00
Above 50,001 Gallons	14.00

These rates apply to irrigation only meters.

The following monthly rates shall hereafter be charged for wastewater services for consumption as measured by water meter readings, excluding irrigation only meters.

**Wastewater Minimum Charges**

Residential	\$18.13
Apartments	\$18.13
Commercial	\$18.13

For the residential class, the minimum charge includes 0-2,000 gallons.

**Volumetric Rate by Customer Class per Thousand Gallons**

Residential: \$7.26 per thousand gallons in excess of the first 2,000 gallons but not to exceed the charge for the winter average consumption. Where a winter average for a customer cannot be determined, the citywide residential winter average will be used.

Apartments: \$7.26 per thousand gallons, excludes irrigation only meters.

Commercial: \$7.26 per thousand gallons, excludes irrigation only meters.

The following monthly rates shall hereafter be charged against all real property, except the qualified exempt properties listed in Ordinance No. 09-06, for drainage utility services furnished by the City of Webster.

**Monthly Fee - Houses**

The residential fee applicable to all single-family through four-plex real properties located within the incorporated limits of the City of Webster, Texas, shall be a flat rate of \$1.24 per month or a total of \$14.88 per year.

**Monthly Fee – Apartments, Condominiums, and Townhomes**

The residential fee applicable to all apartment, condominium, and townhome real properties located within the incorporated limits of the City of Webster, Texas, is based upon the total square footage of impervious surface cover measured for each customer/owner. The formula for calculating the amount due is:

Measured Square Footage of Impervious Surface Cover x \$0.000733 per month

**Monthly Fee – Non-residential**

The non-residential fee applicable to all commercial, industrial, and other non-residential real properties located within the incorporated limits of the City of Webster, Texas, is based upon the total square footage of impervious surface cover measured for each customer/owner. The formula for calculating the amount due is:

Measured Square Footage of Impervious Surface Cover x \$0.000767 per month
