There will be delicious food and wonderful company.




## HOLIDAY YARD DECORATING CONTEST

### SAFETY TIPS FOR THIS HOLIDAY SHOPPING SEASON

take your keys and lock your doors. Shoppers should park in a well-lit area and never leave their cars running unattended.

Your mirrors could also be tipping car thieves off. When looking for unlocked vehicles, thieves often look for 'ears out,' meaning if the side view mirrors are out, your car is possibly unlocked with the key fob inside. The side mirrors fold inwards in certain luxury vehicles once the key fob is no longer in the car. Therefore if the side mirrors are still open on a parked car, thieves can readily know the key is in the vehicle, making it an easy theft target.

- Approved a Webster Economic Development Corporation expenditure for the construction of Myrtle Avenue by Teamwork Construction Services, Inc., for \$565,773.00.
- Approved a Webster Economic Development Corporation expenditure for engineering and surveying services with IDS Engineering Group for the extension of Myrtle Avenue at Rice Creek Lane westward to the I-45 frontage road.
- Approved a Webster Economic Development Corporation

expenditure in the amount of \$267,520 to WB NASA Bypass, LLC.

- Approved the renaming of streets and naming of new streets in the Flyway project.
- Designated Mayor Pro Tem Beverly Gaines as the Representative and Councilmember Martin Graves as the Alternate to the Houston-Galveston Area Council 2022 Assembly.
